RE: UM 2208 – Portland General Electric Company’s Wildfire Protection Plan

Dear Filing Center,

Portland General Electric Company (“PGE”) filed its Wildfire Mitigation Plan (“WMP”) for the 2022 fire season with the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (“OPUC”) on December 30, 2021.

Per Section 5.3 High Risk Fire Zones (HRFZ), page 13, PGE stated that it will provide maps of its most current HRFZs, including GIS shape files, to OPUC Safety staff by April 1, 2022. PGE’s HRFZ and Public Safety Power Shutoff (“PSPS”) Area Viewer are available to OPUC Staff at:

Section 5.3 of the 2022 WMP also states that an interactive GIS-enabled map will be posted on PGE’s website (portlandgeneral.com). The map is now active on PGE’s Wildfire Outages & PSPS page and includes a feature that allows customers to enter their address into the map to determine whether their home or business is located within an active PSPS area. This map and layer are publicly available to anyone with an ArcGIS Online (AGOL) account for use in their own ArcGIS system(s). The URL for the 2022 PSPS Areas layer is:
