PROPOSED PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE

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8 Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Staff) submits this proposed
9 procedural schedule pursuant to the Administrative Law Judge (ALJ)'s March 14, 2022
10 Scheduling Memorandum. In the Memorandum, the ALJ instructed parties to UE 400 to provide
11 a proposed procedural schedule by 3:00 p.m. on Wednesday, March 23, 2022.

12 Staff has conferred with the parties that have intervened in this proceeding as well as
13 those entities that have filed a petition to intervene that is currently pending. The parties include
14 PacifiCorp, the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board, the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers, and
15 Calpine Energy Solutions, LLC. The entities that have pending petitions to intervene are the
16 Klamath Water Users' Association and Farm Bureau Federation, the Northwest Intermountain
17 Independent Power Producers, and Sierra Club. All parties and entities that have filed petitions
