Revises tariff PUC Or. No. 3 Access Services as required by FCC Order
No. 20-143.**

I have reviewed this filing and recommend that an acknowledgement letter be sent. The filing was submitted on May 31, 2022, and will go into effect on July 1, 2022.

This filing revises Canby Telephone Association's Tariff PUC Or. No 3, Access Services, as required by FCC Order No. 20-143; Part 51 – Interconnection; Subpart M – 8YY Transition; §51.909 Transition of rate-of-return carrier access charges; Step 3.

This filing includes tariff revisions for the following seven (7) companies:

- Canby Telephone Association
- Clear Creek Mutual Telephone Company
- Eagle Telephone System, Inc.
- Molalla Communications Company
- Mt. Angel Telephone Company
- Nehalem Telecommunications, Inc.
- Scio Mutual Telephone Association

This filing is made in compliance with the Federal Communication Commission's (FCC) Order 20-143; Part 51 – Interconnection; Subpart M – 8YY Transition; §51.909 Transition of rate-of-return carrier access charges; Step 3. The FCC Order further established a three step glidepath reduction to a uniform, nationwide toll free database query rate. Step 3 requires interstate and intrastate originating End Office Access Service rate elements for Toll Free Calls to be reduced by one-half. The 7 companies propose a reduction to the required rate level.

Other than noted above, this filing will not increase any rate or charge, cause the withdrawal of service, or conflict with other schedules. This filing is revenue neutral for these Companies.

It is requested that this filing become effective July 1, 2022.
