I have reviewed this filing and recommend that an acknowledgement letter be sent. The filing was submitted on June 17, 2022, and will go into effect on July 1, 2022.

Ziply Fiber Northwest, LLC d/b/a Ziply Fiber, hereby submits the attached revisions to the Oregon P.U.C. No. 12 Intrastate Access Tariff with an effective date of July 1, 2022. The purpose of this filing is to reduce certain originating 8YY charges.

This filing proposes the second step in implementing the 8YY Access Service reductions mandated in the Federal Communications Commission's October 9, 2020, Report and Order in WC Docket No. 18-156, (FCC 20-143), (8YY Access Charge Reform). Beginning July 1, 2022, each Price Cap Carrier shall:

- 1. Reduce its interstate and intrastate rates for all originating End Office Access Service rate elements for Toll Free Calls in each state in which it provides such service by one-half of the maximum rate allowed in Step 1.
- 2. Reduce its rates for interstate and intrastate Toll Free Database Query Charges by one-half of the difference between the rate permitted in Step 1 and the transitional rate of \$0.0002 per query.

It is requested that this filing become effective July 1, 2022.
