Your memorandum issued April 14 Says," Additionally, please note that the Commission may identify witnesses it wishes to question on Thursday, April 20, 2023, if any, as late as the end of the day on Wednesday, April 19, 2023. This may include witnesses not identified by any party in a cross-examination statement. Accordingly, all witnesses should remain available for the hearing on Thursday, April 20, 2023."
