To the authority of Oregon's PUC I would like to appeal the motion of denial leveled against Stop B2H. Idaho Power has not given proper notification to all persons that will be impacted by the transmission line. The law judge's decision to deny proper notifications reveals a lack of concern for the landowners of Oregon. I have been in contact with our neighbors who live approximately one half mile from the transmission line and have received no notification of their impact. We know that noise levels are now impacting people a half mile away from the line. The disrespect shown to Oregon citizens by not allowing them to have a public comment on this issue is fraudulent. I have no idea how Idaho Power gets a pass to impact Oregon landowners in this negative way so easily. I am asking that the law judge review this order on behalf of the landowners that have no idea what is going on.

I would also like to express my disappointment with the contested case process. I have to become a computer specialist and a paralegal in order to comply with the restrictions and conditions necessary to stay in this process.
