3. PacifiCorp is an electric public utility in the state of Oregon and is subject to the jurisdiction of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission).

4. PacifiCorp has been engaged in negotiations with Idaho Power Company (Idaho Power) and the Bonneville Power Administration (BPA) regarding the Boardman to Hemingway (B2H) transmission project, which is the subject of the certificate of public convenience and necessity application that initiated this docket. As explained in a letter to the Commission submitted in docket 78, Idaho Power's 2021 Integrated Resource Plan, PacifiCorp is committed to working with Idaho Power and the BPA to move forward with the B2H transmission project.

5. No other party can adequately represent the interests of PacifiCorp in this proceeding. As one of the contracting parties in the B2H transmission project, decisions made in the proceeding may directly affect PacifiCorp. Thus, PacifiCorp has a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding.

6. The Company has special knowledge and expertise that may assist the Commission in resolving the issues in the proceeding.

7. PacifiCorp intends to monitor the proceeding and, if necessary, raise issues and submit testimony appropriate to the proceeding.

8. Based on the information provided above in compliance with the Commission's rules of procedure, PacifiCorp requests to participate in these proceedings as an intervenor. PacifiCorp accepts the procedural schedule established in the October 17, 2022, Prehearing Conference Memorandum and the Company's participation in this docket will not unreasonably broaden the issues, burden the record, or delay the proceeding.

PacifiCorp respectfully requests that the Commission grant this petition to intervene.
