
DISPOSITION: MOTION TO ADMIT COUNSEL *PRO HAC VICE* GRANTED

On September 9, 2022, Idaho Power Company, filed a motion to allow, Donovan E. Walker to appear as counsel *pro hac vice* in this proceeding. The affidavit of Donovan E. Walker accompanied the motion. Donovan E. Walker states they will associate with Lisa Rackner, an active member in good standing with the Oregon State Bar.

I have reviewed the motion for admission *pro hac vice* and find that it complies with the requirements of UTCR 3.170 and OAR 860-001-0320. No objections have been received.

The motion to admit Donovan E. Walker as counsel *pro hac vice* on behalf of Idaho Power Company is granted for a one-year period. For cases continuing over one year, an attorney appearing *pro hac vice* must file a new application to continue to participate in the case.¹
