RULING

**DISPOSITION: MOTION FOR EXTENSION GRANTED**

On February 21, 2023, Idaho Power Company filed a motion requesting a one-day extension to the deadline to file the testimony of Dr. Jeffrey Ellenbogen and seeks expedited consideration of its request. Idaho Power explains that this testimony is responsive to Greg Larkin’s testimony regarding the impact of corona noise associated with the Boardman to Hemingway Transmission Line project. Idaho Power requests the additional day to ensure the testimony is appropriately redacted. In an update also filed on February 21, 2023, Idaho Power represents that it consulted with Mr. Larkin and that he does not object to the extension.

For good cause, I grant Idaho Power’s request for a one-day extension to file the testimony of Dr. Jeffrey Ellenbogen. Dr. Jeffrey Ellenbogen’s testimony is due by 3:00 p.m. on February 22, 2023.
