RULING


DISPOSITION: RULINGS CERTIFIED

On January 17, 2023, Sam Myers filed a document seeking “to appeal the motion of denial leveled against Stop B2H.”¹ This document was in reference to my January 13, 2023 ruling denying a motion from STOP B2H Coalition regarding notice for individuals with interests in land to be physically impacted or traversed by the proposed route of the Boardman to Hemingway project. On January 27, 2023, I issued a memorandum explaining that I construed the filing as a request to certify my ruling for the Commission’s consideration under OAR 860-001-0110.

On February 7, 2023, Wendy King filed a document seeking “to respectfully appeal ALJ John Mellgren’s denial of Motion for Extension of my Amended Opening Testimony.”² This document was in reference to my February 7, 2023 ruling granting a petition to intervene with conditions and denying a motion for an extension. I construe Ms. King’s filing as a request to certify my ruling for the Commission’s consideration under OAR 860-001-0110.

After considering the requests, which implicate issues of proper notice and the ability of an intervenor to participate in this case, I find good cause to certify these rulings. I certify my January 17, 2023 ruling denying STOP B2H Coalition’s motion and my February 7, 2023 ruling denying Wendy King’s motion for an extension to the Commission for consideration and disposition under OAR 860-001-0110.
