SUBJECT: Replacement Sheets of Portland General Electric (PGE or Company),
Effective January 19, 2023
Second Supplemental Filing of Advice No. 22-35, Annual Update Tariff

In Order No. 22-427 (Order) entered November 1, 2022, and Corrected Order No. 22-436 entered November 3, 2022, in Docket No. UE 402, the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) adopted a comprehensive stipulation on all issues associated with PGE's 2023 Annual Power Cost Update Tariff (AUT). These rates were approved with an effective date of January 1, 2023. After the rates were put into effect, the Company discovered a typographical error in the posted tariff sheets. In the Fourteenth Revision of Sheet No. 7-3 and the Ninth Revision of Sheet No. 7-4, the summation of the time of use rates were not updated from their previous versions. Customers were billed the correct amounts as the billing system does not use these sums, but instead the individual components of the sum – which were correct. The replacement sheets in the second supplemental filing corrects this mistake. As there is no effective change in rates, Staff does not have concerns about this filing.

Staff has reviewed the Supplemental Filing and finds the mistake was corrected. The checks and analytic tasks required to affirm the accuracy of the tariff sheets were:

- Confirm the sums given in the updated tariff sheets add up to the correct value.
- Confirm that any other sums given in the tariff sheet were also correct.
- Confirm that components of sums are correct.

Staff utilized the provided original work papers and discussions with the Company on January 5, 2023, to verify the accuracy of the tariff sheets.

Staff recommends that an acknowledgement letter be sent, and the tariff sheets as currently filed be allowed to go into effect for service rendered on and after January 19, 2023. Further, Staff asks that this supplemental filing, be treated as compliance filings to Order 22-427 and Order 22-436. The Company agrees with Staff's approach to these materials.
