RULING

DISPOSITION: LATE-FILED TESTIMONY AND EXHIBITS ACCEPTED

On June 22, 2023, Portland General Electric Company filed a motion requesting that the Commission accept the company's late-filed reply testimony. PGE explains that due to technical difficulties, PGE's support staff was unable to meet the 3:00 p.m. deadline despite taking all reasonable steps to resolve the issues and ultimately filed its testimony shortly past the deadline. PGE states that because the company submitted its reply testimony by 3:50 p.m. on June 21, 2023, no party will be prejudiced by the delay.

On June 26, 2023, Staff of the Public Utility Commission of Oregon filed a motion requesting that the Commission accept Staff's late-filed exhibit to its opening testimony. Staff explains that the exhibit, Staff/413, is a compilation of public comments received regarding the rate revision request and states that providing the comments sooner rather than later is preferable for other parties to the docket.

I grant PGE's and Staff's motions and accept the late-filed testimony and exhibits.
