MEMORANDUM REGARDING THE
EVIDENTIARY HEARING

On May 17, 2023, I issued a ruling in these proceedings establishing the procedural schedule, including holding the week of September 11, 2023, for a hearing to the extent that one was necessary. A specific date for the hearing has not yet been proposed or established.

Rather than hold a hearing the week of September 11, 2023, I request that the parties confer and jointly propose a hearing date and time in October 2023. Additionally, I request that the parties confer and propose new deadlines for the briefing schedule, including a date for oral arguments. The date for oral arguments should be scheduled on a Tuesday afternoon or a Thursday.

The parties shall file the proposed schedule by 3:00 p.m. on September 12, 2023. To the extent that the parties are unable to agree on a date and time for the hearing or any other date in the schedule, the parties may each file separate proposal. To the extent that any party wants to hold a procedural conference to discuss the schedule, the party may make such a request by 3:00 p.m. on September 12, 2023.
