**RE: Supplemental Filing of Advice No. 23-04, IBEW Local 125 Labor Rate Update**

Portland General Electric Company (PGE) submits this supplemental filing pursuant to Oregon Revised Statutes 757.205 and 757.210, and Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 860-022-0025, and 860-022-0030 for filing proposed tariff sheets associated with Tariff P.U.C. No. 18. PGE initially filed Advice 23-04 on March 2, 2023, with a requested effective date of April 5, 2023, which remains as filed. PGE submits this Supplemental Filing with updated work papers. The “Average Rate” tabs, columns B, C and D inadvertently had the 2022 Union Rates, however, column G listed the correct 2023 Union Rates. This correction has no impact on the tariff sheets that were originally filed, PGE is resubmitting the workpapers for accuracy.

All sheets remain as previously filed.

To satisfy the requirements of Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR) 860-022-0025 and 860-022-0030, PGE provides the following responses:

PGE has 137 Customers on the above listed streetlighting Schedules. The revenue from this change depends on the number of replacements each year and the number of trouble calls that require after-hours crews.
