RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED

On May 16, 2023, the Northwest & Intermountain Power Producers Coalition (NIPPC) filed a motion for a two-week extension of time to respond to PacifiCorp, dba Pacific Power's motion for modified protective order. NIPPC states the purpose for the extension is that it has concerns with PacifiCorp's initial proposal and is in discussion to see an amicable resolution. NIPPC is requesting expedited consideration of the motion because responses were due May 16, 2023. NIPPC asserts that the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers, Sierra Club, the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board, NewSun Energy LLC, Swan Lake Hydro North LLC, and FFP Project 101 do not oppose the extension of time and is not aware of any objections to the motion.

Finding that there are no objections, I find good cause to grant the motion on an expedited basis. Responses to PacifiCorp's motion for modified protective order are due on May 30, 2023, and the company's reply is due on June 6, 2023.¹
