RULING

**DISPOSITION: DEADLINES ESTABLISHED**

On March 14, 2024, the Oregon Citizens' Utility Board (CUB) filed a motion to dismiss or segregate certain issues in this case. CUB's motion asks the Commission to dismiss Portland General Electric Company's rate case in its entirety. In the alternative, CUB asks that the Commission segregate certain issues to be decided at a public meeting.

Parties should respond to CUB's motion on our substantive motion timelines as laid out by rule. Under those rules, responses are due within 15 days of filing the motion or March 29, 2024.<sup>1</sup> Replies are due within 7 days of responses, or April 5, 2024.

Parties should be prepared to discuss dates for an oral argument on CUB's motion at the prehearing conference scheduled in this case for Thursday, March 21, 2024.
