
**DISPOSITION: MOTIONS GRANTED; STIPULATION, TESTIMONY, AND EXHIBITS
ADMITTED; RECORD CLOSED**

On May 13, 2024, Idaho Power Company filed a motion to admit the stipulation filed in this docket on May 13, 2024, into this proceeding's record. On May 16, 2024, Idaho Power filed a motion to admit the pre-filed exhibits and testimony of Jessica G. Brady (Idaho Power/100-109 and Idaho Power/200-205) along with the declaration of Ms. Brady attesting that the pre-filed testimony and exhibits are true and correct. No party opposed Idaho Power's motions.

I find the testimony and exhibits offered by the parties and supported by declarations of the witness meet the standards for relevance as required by OAR 860-001-0450(1) and satisfy the requirements of OAR 860-001-0480. I grant Idaho Power's motions. The stipulation, testimony, and exhibits are admitted into the record as identified in Idaho Power's motions.
