**NOTICE OF USE OF GENERAL
PROTECTIVE ORDER**

1 Sunriver Water LLC (“Sunriver Water” or “Company”) hereby provides notice
2 that it is designating information to be produced or used in this docket as protected
3 under the Commission's General Protective Order No. 23-132 (GPO).

4 On March 27, 2024, Sunriver Water filed its application for a general rate
5 case. Staff submitted its first set of DRs on April 22, 2024. Certain information in
6 response to Staff’s DRs in this docket include confidential material, including
7 confidential employee data. Specifically, Staff DR 1 requests the following:
8 “Regarding the Company’s response to application question 22, please provide the
9 unredacted wage/salary information.” Public disclosure of the confidential
10 information could be detrimental to Sunriver Water and its customers. In addition,
11 Sunriver Water anticipates that Staff and any intervenors will seek to discover
12 additional confidential business information in the discovery process.

13 The Commission’s rules authorize Sunriver Water to seek reasonable
14 restrictions on discovery of trade secrets and other confidential business information.
15 See OAR 860-001-0080 and ORCP 36(C)(1) (providing protection against
16 unrestricted discovery of “trade secret[s] or other confidential research,
17 development, or commercial information”). Issuance of a protective order will
18 facilitate the production of relevant information and expedite the discovery process.
