13	limited reply, to clarify one argument raised in Staff's briefs. NPCC does not take a position on	
14	the merit's of Staff's argument, only that if the Commission upholds the argument, it should do	
15	so on narrow grounds.	
16	Staff argues in its opening brief that "the filed rate doctrine prevents the	
17	Commission from retroactively altering the price caps established in Order No. 01-810." Staff's	
18	Opening Brief at 6. As the NPCC understands Staff's argument, the Staff is only seeking to	
19	apply the filed rate doctrine to Qwest's proposed increase to residential caller ID services and is	
20	not implying that the filed rate doctrine should have any impact on PAL services. Assuming that	
21	Staff did not intend any broader application than that, then the NPCC does not take issue with	
22	Staff's argument.	
23	At this stage of this docket, it is important to recognize that since the FCC	
24	preempted Qwest's PAL rates in 1996 pursuant	to 47 U.S.C. § 276(c), the state filed rate doctrine
