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Page 1 - AVISTA CORPORATION'S PETITION TO INTERVENE

Avista has a direct and substantial interest in this proceeding, in which the Commission has announced it will immediately begin an investigation into its delegated authority to engage in retroactive ratemaking. In re Application of Portland General Electric Co. for an Investigation into Least Cost Plan Plant Retirement, DR 10/UE 88/UM 989, Order 07-157 at 9 (OPUC Apr. 19, 2007). Recognizing the direct and substantial interest utilities like Avista have in this proceeding, the Commission has observed that, "[g]iven the generality and breadth of this issue, we expect that other parties, in addition to those now active in these joint remand proceedings, will want to participate."
