The rule at issue is ORS 16 860-038-0020(3), which requires the Committee, on or before July 1 of each year, recommend 17 portfolio options to the Commission. 18 There is good cause for the Committee's inability to meet the July 1 date. 19 At the Committee meeting of February 6, 2009, both PacifiCorp and Portland General 20 Electric suggested a change in Commission policy to allow sourcing of renewable energy 21 certificates (RECs) from outside the region, based on their assumption that there may be a 22 dramatic rise in the cost of RECS registered by Western Renewable Energy Generation 23 Information Systems, known as WREGIS.
