RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME GRANTED

On November 29, 2004, Northwest Public Communications Council (NPCC, formerly Northwest Payphone Association) filed a motion for summary judgment with the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission). NPCC asks the Commission to determine that Qwest Corporation (Qwest) is liable under applicable federal law to pay refunds to NPCC members for payphone access line overcharges.

On December 3, 2004, Qwest filed a motion requesting an extension of time through January 3, 2005 in which to respond to NPCC's motion for summary judgment. Qwest affirms that it has conferred with NPCC's counsel, who does not object to the request.

The motion for extension of time is granted. Qwest shall respond to NPCC's motion no later than January 4, 2005.
