
RULING

DISPOSITION: SCHEDULE SUSPENDED

On April 27, 2010, the Northwest Public Communications Council, *et al.* (NPCC), filed a procedural motion requesting several changes to the schedule in these proceedings (the April 27 Motion), include a request to suspend the briefing schedule established on March 11, 2010. The briefing schedule included only two deadlines: April 30 for filing motions for summary judgment; and May 28 for filing responses to the motions for summary judgment. Qwest filed its motion for summary judgment on April 30. On May 5, 2010, I issued a ruling denying NPCC's April 27 Motion.

Due to confusion about the procedural status of this case, including questions about the status of pending motions, I am temporarily suspending the procedural schedule and scheduling a telephone conference with the parties. A separate notice with details about the telephone conference will be issued shortly. This suspension does not apply to NPCC's pending application for reconsideration of Order No. 10-027.
