RULING


**DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED; TIME EXTENDED IN WHICH  
TO FILE THIRD AMENDED COMPLAINT**

On February 12, 2010, counsel for the Northwest Public Communications Council (NPCC) filed a Stipulated Motion for Enlargement of Time to File Third Amended Complaint (Motion) by one day until February 17, 2010, to allow counsel to resolve language issues in the final draft. NPCC also filed a Declaration in Support of the Motion. NPCC states Qwest should be allowed the same time to Answer. Counsel for Qwest has stipulated to this motion.

**RULING**

Good cause having been shown, the Stipulated Motion for Enlargement of Time to File Third Amended Complaint is GRANTED. NCPP's Third Amended Complaint is due Wednesday, February 17, 2010, and Qwest Corporation's Answer is due Thursday, March 9, 2010.
