RULING

DISPOSITION: MOTION GRANTED; TIME EXTENDED IN WHICH
TO FILE AMENDED COMPLAINT


Under the previously agreed upon schedule, The Northwest Public Communications Council (NPCC) was to file an amended complaint with the Commission no later than July 27, 2009. On July 22, 2009, NPCC filed a Notice of Withdrawal and Substitution of Counsel in this case.

On July 24, 2009, NPCC counsel filed a Stipulated Motion for Enlargement of Time to File an Amended Complaint (Motion), requesting that the time for filing the amended complaint be extended until August 17, 2009. Counsel for both NPCC and Qwest Corporation signed the Motion.

RULING

I find that the substitution of counsel provides a good and reasonable cause for an extension of time in which to file the amended complaint; the delay of three weeks will not unduly delay the proceedings or burden the record. The Stipulated Motion for Enlargement of Time to File an Amended Complaint is GRANTED.
