**DISPOSITION: PROPOSED FINDINGS OF FACT TO BE FILED.**

Verizon Northwest Inc. (Verizon) appealed Order No. 03-531 to the Marion County Circuit Court. On September 24, 2004, Circuit Court Judge Jamese Rhoades issued an opinion remanding this matter to the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission). In her opinion, Judge Rhoades stated that the Commission failed to make the requisite findings of fact and conclusions of law.

While no action is necessary until a judgment is entered by the Circuit Court, I want to inform the parties of the process to be used in this docket. Commission Staff (Staff) and Verizon are to each draft and file proposed findings of fact no later than 45 days after the judgment is entered by the Circuit Court. The proposed findings of facts should include citations to the record. Upon receipt, the new proposed facts will be reviewed and incorporated, as appropriate, in a Commission order.
