
- Rule F – correct title by changing “discontinue” to “discontinuance”

- Schedule 76 – add new schedule - Flex Peak Program (Optional)
- Schedule 80 – change from 80-1 – 80-12 to 80-1 – 80-7
- Schedule 82 – change from 82-1 – 82-3 to 82-1 – 82-2
- Schedule 83 – change from 83-1 – 83-3 to 83-1 – 83-5
- Schedule 85 – change from 85-1 – 85-11 to 85-1 – 85-13
- Schedule 88 – change from 88-1 – 88-5 to 8-1 – 88-6
- Schedule 92 – change title to Boardman Operating Life Adjustment
