12	Commission to authorize the deferral of expenses or revenues of a public utility for

15	On June 6, 2003, the Governor signed Or Laws 2003, ch 234 (formerly known				
16	as Senate Bill 205, the "Intervenor Funding Act") into law. Section 2 of the Act				
17	authorizes the Commission to approve written agreements for intervenor funding				
18	grants between electric and natural gas utilities and qualifying organizations				
19	representing broad customer interests. Such grants would be used by these qualifying				
20	organizations when participating in certain types of regulatory proceedings before the				
21	Commission. Section 2 of the Act also authorizes the Commission to establish rules				
22	with respect to funding agreements for determining which organizations are eligible				
23	for financial assistance, the amount of assistance that may be provided, the manner in				
24	which assistance will be distributed, and other necessary administrative matters.

On November 8, 2007 in Order No. 07-487 the Commission approved the Intervenor Funding Agreement between Avista Utilities, Citizens' Utility Board of Oregon (CUB) and Northwest Industrial Gas Users (NWIGU). This agreement established an intervenor funding program for 2007 and provided \$30,000 for each of three funds from which grants could be made (CUB Fund, Preauthorized Matching Fund and an Issues Fund). The parties also agreed that any unspent funds remaining after December 31, 2007 would be carried over and made available for use in 2008 under the same terms of the agreement or under any successor intervenor funding agreement entered into between Avista, CUB and NWIGU for 2008.

In accordance with the statutory authority provided by ORS 757.259(3), as amended, and the Commission's approval of the Intervenor Funding Agreement, Avista proposes to record and defer the amount of any intervenor funding grants for later inclusion in rates with its annual Purchased Gas Adjustment (PGA) filing. The Company will record and defer these ongoing costs upon payment of the Intervenor Funding Grants following the Commission's approval of the Intervenor funding Grant and issuance of an Order directing the company to make payment, pursuant to the Intervenor Funding Agreement.
