RE: UM XXXX In the Matter of PGE's Request for changes to the Time of Day Evaluation

Portland General Electric (PGE) hereby submits this filing to the Commission requesting changes to the Time of Day (TOD) evaluation. PGE seeks Commission Order to move the requirement to provide a comprehensive evaluation report from December 2022 to July 2023; move the \$95,000 evaluation budget in 2022 to 2023 evaluation budget, increasing the later to \$190,000. This reallocation within the 2022-23 budget has no net change to the budget for the period.

At the Public Meeting on January 26, 2021, the Commission adopted Staff's recommendation to approve PGE's Advice No. 20-34 (Docket No. ADV 1194) which updated it's Schedule 7 Residential Time-of-Use Rate. One of the conditions for approval was, "PGE would submit a comprehensive report, which includes a cost-effectiveness analysis, of its Schedule 7 TOU offerings no later than December 2022. PGE agrees to work with Staff and interested parties on the information and analysis in said report;" 1

Prior to making this filing, PGE discussed this request with Staff and Staff supports moving the requirement to provide a comprehensive evaluation report to July 2023 and moving the \$95,000 evaluation budget in 2022 to 2023.

PGE requests Commission consideration of this request by December 31, 2022, to ensure PGE is still in Compliance with Commission direction in ADV 1194.
