17	recovery of costs (the "Deferral Account") associated with declared emergencies. The Deferral		
18	Account will track expenses proximately caused by a declared emergency that is the subject of a		
19	state or federal declaration. After establishment of the Deferral Account, within 30-days following		
20	an actual state of declared emergency, Avista would file a letter notifying the Commission that it		
21	is activating the Deferral Account by describing the emergency event, the general impacts to utility		
22	systems as a result of the event, and any estimate of expenses, if available. Avista will seeks		
23	authorization to amortize the Deferral Account for recovery in a future Commission proceeding.

25	Avista provides natural gas service in southwestern and northeastern Oregon and is a public		
26	utility subject to the Commission's jurisdiction under ORS 757.005(1)(a)(A).

Once the Deferral Account is authorized in accordance with Order No. 21-259, the account would not have to be reauthorized. However, once Avista files a notice indicating it is recording amounts in the Deferral Account, the authority to record amounts related to the declared emergency expires 12 months from the date of the emergency unless reauthorized under the procedures of OAR 860-027-0300(4).

#### B. Reason for Deferral

Under ORS 757.259(2)(e), deferral of utility expenses or revenues is allowed when it will appropriately match the costs borne and benefits received by customers. Deferral of these costs will align the costs of Avista's service with the benefits Avista customers receive from such service.

#### C. Proposed Accounting

Avista proposes to record the deferral as a regulatory asset in FERC Account 182.3 (Other Regulatory Assets), crediting FERC Account 407.4 (Regulatory Credits). In the absence of a deferred accounting order, Avista would record the costs to a variety of accounts. Interest does not accrue on this balancing account.

#### **D.** Estimate of Amounts

Avista cannot estimate the costs associated with a declared emergence at this time. To the extent it is available, an estimate of the amounts associated with a particular declared emergency would be provided with the letter notifying the Commission that it is activating the Deferral Account filed within 30 days of the declaration.
