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II. OAR 860-027-0300(3) REQUIREMENTS

2 A. Description

3 ORS 757.365 (2009), as amended by House Bill 3690 (2010), mandated the 4 development of pilot programs for each electric company to demonstrate the use and 5 effectiveness of volumetric incentive rates and payments for electricity delivered by solar 6 photovoltaic energy systems. The legislation authorized the Commission to establish 7 incentive rates for the pilot programs to enable the development of the most efficient solar photovoltaic systems. As such, in Docket No. UM 1452, and approved with Order No. 10-8 9 198, the Commission established the Pilot Program to demonstrate the use and effectiveness 10 of volumetric incentive rates ("VIR") payments for electricity or for the non-energy attributes 11 of electricity, or both, delivered from a solar photovoltaic system permanently installed by 12 retail electric customers. The Commission allocated 0.4 megawatts of the Pilot Program capacity to Idaho Power and specified it was to be allocated only to residential qualifying 13 systems.1 14

The Commission approved Idaho Power's Solar PV Program Rider effective July 1, 2010.² The Solar PV Program Rider is a balancing account mechanism that charges customers a percentage of the sum of the monthly charges for the base rate components of their electric bill. Base rate components include the service charge, energy charges, demand charges, and the basic charge. Revenues received from the Solar PV Program Rider fund the implementation and administration of the Pilot Program and are recorded in a regulatory liability account. As funds are used for administration of the program and VIR payments, the balancing account is debited for the amount of the expenditure disbursement.

1 With this deferral application, Idaho Power seeks authorization from the Commission 2 to defer, for future true-up, Solar PV Program Rider revenues and Pilot Program 3 expenditures. In addition, the Company requests that the Commission determine that 4 amortization of this deferral does not require an earnings review because it is subject to an 5 automatic adjustment clause under ORS 757.210(1). This treatment is consistent with the 6 cost recovery provisions in ORS 757.365(10) and OAR 860-084-0380, and the cost recovery 7 mechanisms approved for Portland General Electric Company³ and Pacific Power⁴ for the 8 implementation of their Pilot Programs.

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B. <u>Reasons for Deferral</u>

ORS 757.365(10) and OAR 860-084-0380 provide that all prudently incurred costs associated with the Pilot Program are recoverable in rates. In Order No. 10-198, the Commission authorized Idaho Power "to recover 100 percent of its costs through a rider mechanism."⁵ This deferral will capture the difference between the revenues received through the Solar PV Program Rider (*i.e.*, the rider mechanism authorized in Order No. 10-198⁶) and the actual costs of the Pilot Program, thereby ensuring that Idaho Power recovers 100 percent of its costs—no more and no less.

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C. Proposed Accounting

Idaho Power records revenues and expenses that would be subject to the deferral
order in accordance with the Code of Federal Regulations to the Federal Energy Regulatory
Commission Account 254 (Regulatory Liability).

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D. <u>Estimate of Amounts</u>

As of September 30, 2018, the Oregon jurisdictional Solar PV Program Rider balance was approximately \$5.3 million, meaning since implementation the Company has collected from customers \$5.3 million more than the total implementation, administration, and VIR payment expenditures that have been paid. The Company estimates net amounts deferred beginning the date of this Application through September 2019 to be approximately \$900,000, for a total balance of \$6.2 million.

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III. CONCLUSION

17 Continued Commission approval of the ongoing operation of the Solar PV Program 18 Rider balancing account is consistent with the Commission direction in Order No. 10-198. 19 For the reasons stated above, Idaho Power requests permission to defer revenues collected 20 through the Solar PV Program Rider and expenditures associated with the implementation

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mechanism for the Pilot Program. The Commission approved both tariff schedules effective July 1, 2010.
