PLEASE READ ALL DOCUMENTS CAREFULLY – DIRECT ALL CORRESPONDENCE TO THE PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION OF OREGON

On December 16, 2016, a representative from your company met with Public Utility Commission of Oregon's Enforcement Committee to discuss an alleged rule violation. At that meeting, an agreement was reached regarding penalties for the violation.

Enclosed are two sets of documents that contain a Complaint and a Stipulation. The Complaint serves as a formal notice to you of the violation you were charged with and requires that you Answer the allegation. Because you already reached an agreement with the Enforcement Committee, you do not need to submit an Answer. Instead, you need only sign and return the enclosed Stipulation in order to answer the Complaint. If you had not reached an agreement with the Enforcement Committee, filing an Answer would be your opportunity to admit or deny the allegation and, if denied, to ask for a formal hearing.

The Stipulation sets forth the terms and conditions of the agreement you reached with the Enforcement Committee. To finalize the settlement, you must sign the original Stipulation and mail it within 20 days of the date of this letter to:

You do not need to make payment until the Commission has approved the Stipulation. The Commission should issue an order adopting the Stipulation within 30 days of its receipt. Please retain the extra copy of the Stipulation for your files.

If for some reason you no longer agree to the terms of the Stipulation, you MUST FILE AN ANSWER TO THE COMPLAINT, admitting or denying the allegation, or a default order may be issued.

2	OUNC adopted OAR 952-001-0090 which was in effect at all times herein relevant. The	
3	rule provides in relevant part:	
4	(2) Once underground facilities have been marked, the excavator shall:	
5 6	(c) Employ hand tools or other such non-invasive methods to determine the exact location of the underground facility when excavation is to be made within the reasonable accuracy zone.

8	On or about September 21, 2016, Defendant violated OAR 952-001-0090(2)(c), in that	
9	Defendant failed to expose marked facilities by hand while performing an excavation at or near	
10	551 SW Industrial Way, Bend, Oregon.

12	ORS 757.993 provides, in relevant part, that:	
13	any rule of the Oregon Utility Notification Center shall incur a penalty of not more than \$1,000 for the first violation and not more than \$5,000 for each subsequent violation."

19	WHEREFORE, the Commission directs Defendant to file a verified answer to this	
20	Complaint within twenty (20) days from the date this Complaint is mailed to Defendant.

2	The	e parties further agree that the Commission may enter an order assessing civil
3	monetary p	penalties against Defendant in the amount of \$1,000 under the following terms and
4	conditions	
5	A.	Defendant must sign and return this Stipulation within 20 days of the date it was
6		served upon (mailed to) Defendant.
7	В.	\$200 becomes due and payable on or before the 30 th day following the Commission's
8		entry of its order in this case.
9	C.	Payment must be by <u>cashier's check</u> or <u>money order</u> made out to the <u>Public Utility</u>
10		Commission of Oregon, and the memo line of the money order must state the "NC
11		360" docket number in the caption of this Stipulation.
12	D.	Payment of the balance of the penalties (\$800) will be permanently suspended and no
13		further penalties will be imposed for the violation alleged in the Complaint unless
14		Defendant fails to comply with all of the terms of this Stipulation and all of the rules
15		adopted by the Oregon Utility Notification Center (OUNC) under ORS 757.552 for a
16		one-year period following the date of the Commission's entry of an order.
17	E.	Defendant must contact the OUNC Speakers Bureau online at
18		www.digsafelyoregon.com or by calling (503) 232-1987 to arrange for and attend a
19		training session on Oregon excavation laws within 45 days following the entry of the
20		Commission's order. All employees of Defendant that perform excavation work must
21		attend a training session.
22	F.	Defendant must also contact Bill Walker at Cascade Natural Gas (CNG) by email
23		William. Walker@cngc.com or by calling (541) 706-6290 to arrange for and attend an
24		operator safety presentation provided by CNG within 45 days following the entry of
25		the Commission's order. All employees of Defendant that perform excavation work

must attend a safety presentation from CNG.

1		G.	Defendant must take a blank copy of the Training Verification form attached to this
2			Stipulation as Attachment 1 to all required trainings under Paragraphs 4.E and 4.F
3			above. Each individual attending training must sign the form to verify attendance. A
4			representative of the organization providing the training (Instructor) must sign the
5			Training Verification form that the training is complete with respect to the individuals
6			listed on the Training Verification form for the form to be complete. Defendant shall
7			return all completed Training Verification forms to Complainant at the address on the
8			form within 10 days of date of the last training session and in no event no later than
9			55 days following the date of the Commission's entry of an order in this docket.
10		H.	In the event that Complainant contends that Defendant has not complied with all of
11			the terms of this Stipulation and all OUNC rules for that one-year period,
12			Complainant may reopen this proceeding and petition for imposition of all or a
13			portion of the suspended penalties. In such case, Defendant is entitled to a notice and
14			hearing on the basis upon which Complainant contends that compliance has not
15			occurred.
16		I.	Complainant's failure to enforce any provision of this Stipulation, or decision to
17			waive any violation or nonperformance of this Stipulation in one instance, will not
18			constitute a waiver by the Complainant of that provision, any other provision, or any
19			other violation or nonperformance in another instance.
