Re: Violation of Oregon Utility Notification Center Rules DOJ File No. 860140-GB0193-19 / Docket No. NC 391

PLEASE READ ALL DOCUMENTS CAREFULLY – DIRECT ALL CORRESPONDENCE TO THE PUBLIC UTILITY COMMISSION OF OREGON

On February 20, 2019, a representative from your company participated in a telephone conference with the Public Utility Commission of Oregon's Enforcement Committee to discuss an alleged rule violation. At that conference, an agreement was reached regarding penalties for the violation.

Enclosed are two sets of documents that contain a Complaint and a Stipulation. The Complaint serves as a formal notice to you of the violation you were charged with and requires that you Answer the allegation. Because you already reached an agreement with the Enforcement Committee, you do not need to submit an Answer. Instead, you need only sign and return the enclosed Stipulation in order to answer the Complaint. If you had not reached an agreement with the Enforcement Committee, filing an Answer would be your opportunity to admit or deny the allegation and, if denied, to ask for a formal hearing.

The Stipulation sets forth the terms and conditions of the agreement you reached with the Enforcement Committee. To finalize the settlement, you must sign the original Stipulation and mail it within 20 days of the date of this letter to:

The Commission should issue an order adopting the Stipulation within 30 days of its receipt. Please retain the extra copy of the Stipulation for your files.

3	rule provides in relevant part:	
4	(3) Once underground facilities have been marked, the excavator must:	
5	(b) Stop excavating in the vicinity of the underground facility and notify the Oregon Utility Notification Center to have the route remarked as specified	
6	in these rules, if prior to or during the excavation process, the markings or route of any underground facility is removed or no longer visible;

9	On or about January 4, 2019, Defendant violated OAR 952-001-0090(3), in that	
10	Defendant failed to maintain locate marks and continued excavating without having underground	
11	facilities remarked while performing an excavation at or near 446 SW 9 th Street, Redmond,	
12	Oregon.

14	ORS 757.993 provides, in relevant part, that:	
15	"* * * every person who violates or who procures, aids or abets in the violation of	
16	any rule of the Oregon Utility Notification Center shall incur a penalty of not	
17

19	Defendant has not violated OUNC rules in the past.

21	WHEREFORE, the Commission directs Defendant to file a verified answer to this	
22	Complaint within twenty (20) days from the date this Complaint is mailed to Defendant.	
23	If no verified answer or other written appearance raising a question of fact or law is filed	
24	with the Commission at its office in Salem, Oregon, within the 20-day period, the

2	The parties further agree that the Commission may enter an order assessing a civil
3	monetary penalty against Defendant in the amount of \$1,000 under the following terms and
4	conditions:
5	A. Defendant must sign and return this Stipulation within 20 days of the date it was
6	served upon (mailed to) Defendant.
7	B. Payment of the civil penalty (\$1,000) is suspended and will be waived with no further
8	penalties imposed for the violation alleged in the complaint unless Defendant fails to
9	comply with all of the terms of this Stipulation and all of the rules adopted by the
10	Oregon Utility Notification Center (OUNC) under ORS 757.552 for a one-year period
11	following the date of the Commission's entry of an order.
12	C. Unless Defendant has already done so, Defendant must contact Cascade Natural Gas
13	(CNG) by email <u>cody.cox@cngc.com</u> or by calling (541) 706-6281 and arrange for
14	and ensure that all of Defendant's employees that engage in excavation activity as a
15	part of their job duties attend an operator safety presentation provided by CNG within
16	45 days following the entry of a final order.
17	D. Defendant must take a blank copy of the Training Verification form attached to this
18	Stipulation as Attachment 1 to document all required trainings scheduled under
19	paragraph 4.C. above. Defendant must ensure that all of its employees attending a
20	required training sign a Training Verification form to verify attendance. A
21	representative of the organization providing the training (Instructor) must sign the
22	Training Verification form to verify each person listed on the form completed the
23	training. Defendant must return all completed Training Verification forms to
24	Complainant at the address on the Form within 10 days of the date of the last training
25	session and in no event later than 55 days following the date of the Commission's
26	entry of an order in this docket.
