requirement that InFlow provide customers 90 days prior notice of its intention to abandon
certain services. InFlow fully intends to provide notices including all of the information required
by that rule; however, InFlow requests permission to provide such notice 30 days prior to
abandonment of service instead of 90 days. In support of this Petition, InFlow provides the

On July 1, 2005, InFlow submitted an electronic Application for Transfer of Certificate of Authority to Provide Competitive Telecommunications Services in Oregon, seeking to transfer that certificate to a corporate affiliate, SunGard Network Solutions Inc. ("SNS").¹ On June 30, 2005, InFlow and SNS submitted a letter to Ms. Lois Meerdink of Commission Staff explaining the relationship between InFlow and SNS and the background and reason for requesting the

transfer. As stated in that letter, InFlow's parent corporation has been acquired by SunGard SAS 1 Holdings Inc. ("SASH"), an indirect, wholly-owned subsidiary of SunGard Data Systems Inc. 2 ("SDS"), a publicly traded Delaware corporation. SNS is another indirect, wholly-owned 3 subsidiary of SDS. In connection with a pending transaction, all of the assets and liabilities of 4 InFlow will be transferred to SunGard Availability Services LP ("SASLP"), an affiliate of SNS; 5 however, the Oregon certificate currently held by InFlow will be assigned to SNS. SASLP will 6 continue to operate the business of InFlow, although SNS will provide the telecommunications 7 services currently included as a component of the services provided to some Inflow customers. 8 InFlow currently provides a combination of complex hosting services, managed 9 information technology services, infrastructure management, business continuity services 10 (including disaster recovery and testing), internet access and related network services to its 11 business customers who locate their servers and other equipment in InFlow's data centers, 12 including a data center located in Oregon. The certificate held by InFlow authorizes it to provide 13 non-switched (dedicated), private line, point-to-point, data transmission services between a 14 customer's facilities and the customer's equipment located at the InFlow Data Network 15 Exchange. InFlow's data transmission services are offered only as a component of a broader, 16 enhanced service offering provided by InFlow to its customers, and they represent only a small 17 portion of the overall services that InFlow offers to customers. At the current time, InFlow 18 provides such data transmission services pursuant to its Commission certificate to approximately 19 20 customers. There will be no interruption of service to those customers, but they will receive 20 the services from a different SDS subsidiary once the Commission grants the application to 21 transfer the certificate to SNS. 22 InFlow intends to send the notice letters required by OAR860-032-0020(11)(a) to 23

affected customers by electronic mail by July 15,2005, and by regular mail the week of July 18,
2005. In order to accomplish its corporate reorganization most efficiently, InFlow would like to
transfer its customers for data transmission services to SNS as soon as the Commission approves

31,2005. Accordingly, InFlow seeks a waiver of the requirement to provide customers 90 days
prior notice of its abandonment of service, and to provide only 30 days notice.

InFlow does not believe that any customer will be prejudiced by the requested waiver. 4 InFlow provides data transmission services to its customers only incidentally to, and as a 5 component of a broader array of services. Moreover, these customers use the data transmission 6 services only to access their equipment at InFlow's facility; they do not utilize the services for 7 other communications needs and do not use them for voice service. Accordingly, InFlow does 8 not expect that its customers will object to the transfer of service to **SNS**. Moreover, given the 9 relatively small number of such customers, InFlow can easily handle any questions or customer 10 requests to utilize another carrier for such services within a 30 day period. InFlow also does not 11 believe that the Commission will be inconvenienced by this shorter notice period. InFlow does 12 not anticipate that any of its customers will have questions for the Commission, but if they did 13 the Commission should be able to handle them without inconvenience. 14

For all of these reasons, InFlow respectfully requests that the Commission waive the requirement that Inflow provide customers notice of its intention to abandon services at least 90 days prior to such abandonment and allow InFlow to provide such notice 30 days prior to abandonment of service.
