21	hereby files with the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Commission) this application for						
22	reauthorization (Application) to use deferred accounting pursuant to ORS 727.210 and						
23	757.259, and OAR 860-27-300, for the 12-month period beginning October 1, 2005. The						
24	company's last reauthorization commenced October 1, 2004, and, therefore, the existing						
25	12-month reauthorization period has not yet expired. This application for reauthorization						
26	seeks reauthorization for the period beginning October 1, 2005 through October 1, 2006.						
27	NW Natural requests that, as part of its reauthorization, the Commission						
28	approve NW Natural's automatic adjustment clauses and the Purchased Gas Adjustment						
29	(PGA), pursuant to ORS 727.210(1). See Order Nos. 89-1046, 99-272, and 99-697.

1 Specifically, in this Application, NW Natural requests reauthorization to defer: 2 A. One hundred percent (100%) of the difference between the gas cost demand 3 charges collected from rates and the actual gas cost fixed/demand charges experienced 4 by the company as previously authorized in Order No. 89-1046, 99-272, and 99-697; 5 B. The commodity charge variation as defined in NW Natural's P.U.C. Or. 24 Tariff 6 Schedule P, or its successor, and; 7 C. All previously-authorized account balances related to lost margin and DSM 8 program costs, and PGA commodity and capacity cost deferrals not presently authorized 9 for amortization, or being proposed for amortization, all as described in NWN Advice No. 10 OPUC 05-9. 11 In compliance with the requirements of OAR 860-027-0300(4), NW Natural 12 hereby submits the following information: 13 1. A description of the utility expenses or revenues for which deferred 14 accounting is requested: 15 Demand and other fixed gas costs to be recovered or refunded at one a. 16 hundred percent (100%) of the difference between the actual cost experienced and the 17 amount collected from rates pursuant to P.U.C. Or. 24 Tariff Schedule P, or its successor, 18 and; 19 b. Commodity gas cost variations to be recovered or refunded as 20 described in NW Natural's P.U.C. Or. 24 Tariff Schedule P, or its successor. 21

1 2. Justification for the deferred accounting requested with reference to the 2 sections of *ORS* 757.259 under which deferral can be authorized:

a. Deferral of items 1(a) and 1(b) above can be authorized pursuant to *ORS 757.259(2)(d)* because they are "utility expenses or revenues, the recovery or refund
of which the commission finds should be deferred in order to minimize the frequency of rate
changes ... or to match appropriately the costs borne by and benefits received by
ratepayers."

3. The accounts proposed for recording the amounts to be deferred and the
accounts that would be used for recording the amounts in the absence of approval of
deferred accounting are as follows:

a. The charges incurred for gas costs pursuant to the PGA activity and
 other incurred gas costs, absent the requested account 191 deferral, would be recorded as
 increases/decreases in the appropriate 401 gas expense subaccount.

14 4. An estimate of the amount to be recorded in the deferred accounts for the

15 12-month period subsequent to the Application is attached as Exhibit A. Because of

16 market fluctuations, capacity and commodity deferral amounts are impossible to estimate.

17 Because the Collection vs. Incurred Demand account reflects cyclical collection differences

- 18 rather than market fluctuations, an estimate for this account is included.
- 19 5. A description and explanation of the entries in the deferred accounts on the
- 20 date of this Application for Reauthorization has been provided above in item 4 and is

21 further illustrated in the attached Exhibit A.
