In the Matter of the Application of Portland General Electric Company for an Accounting Order Authorizing Deferral Of Excess Power Costs Application for Deferred Accounting of Annual Power Cost Variance

Pursuant to ORS 757.210, ORS 757.259 and OAR 860-027-0300, Portland General

Electric Company ("PGE") hereby requests an accounting order authorizing PGE to defer for

later ratemaking treatment annual net variable power cost variances pursuant to Order

No. 07-015 and PGE tariff Schedule 126. Schedule 126 is an "automatic adjustment clause" as

defined in ORS 757.210. PGE seeks authorization for this deferral effective as of the effective

date of Schedule 126. In support of this Application, PGE states:

- PGE is a public utility in the state of Oregon and its rates, services and accounting practices are subject to the regulation of the Oregon Public Utility Commission ("Commission").
- 2. This application is filed pursuant to ORS 757.259, which allows the Commission, upon application, to authorize deferral of certain items for later incorporation in rates.

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#### I. OAR 860-027-0300 Requirements

The following is provided pursuant to OAR 860-027-0300(3):

#### a. <u>Description</u>

With this deferral application, PGE seeks authorization from the Commission to accrue, for future amortization, the difference between annual actual net variable power costs and the net variable power costs forecasted pursuant to tariff Schedule 125, in accordance with Order No. 07-015. The annual variance will be determined pursuant to the terms of Schedule 126, which includes a Positive Annual Power Cost Deadband for a positive annual variance, a Negative Annual Power Cost Deadband for negative annual variance, and an earnings test.

#### b. <u>Reasons for Deferral</u>

In Order 07-015, the Commission ordered the adoption of an Annual Power Cost Variance Mechanism ("APCVM") for PGE. PGE Schedule 126 contains the terms of the APCVM. The APCVM provides for recognition in rates of the difference, for a given year, between the actual net variable power costs incurred by PGE and the net variable power costs forecasted pursuant to PGE Schedule 125. This deferral is to capture the net variable power cost difference that will be amortized in rates

This deferral is filed pursuant to Order 07-115 and ORS §757.259(2)(e). This deferral will minimize the frequency of rate changes or the fluctuation of rate levels or match appropriately the costs borne by and benefits received by customers.

### c. <u>Proposed Accounting</u>

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PGE proposes to record the Deferred Amount in FERC Account 182.3 (Regulatory Assets); crediting FERC Account 456 (Other Revenue) if there is an amount to collect from customers. PGE would record the Deferred Amount in FERC 254 (Regulatory Liabilities); debiting FERC Account 456 (Other Revenue) if there is a refund to customers. In the absence of a deferred accounting order from the Commission, PGE would record costs associated with the Deferred Amount to FERC 501 (Fuel), FERC 547 (Fuel), FERC 447 (Sales for Resale), FERC 565 (Transmission by Others) and FERC 555 (Purchased Power).

#### d. <u>Estimate of Amounts</u>

The Deferred Amount is a function of several unknown and unpredictable factors customer usage, the wholesale market price for electricity, and the wholesale market price for natural gas. Since the Deferred Amount is dependent on factors that cannot be precisely forecast, PGE cannot provide a precise estimate of the Deferred Amount. PGE requests that, in accordance with ORS 757.259(4), it be allowed to accrue interest on the unamortized balance at a rate equal to its authorized weighted average cost of capital (set at 8.29% in Order 07-015).

#### e. <u>Notice</u>

A copy of the Notice of Application for Deferred Accounting of Excess Power Costs due to Plant Outage and a list of persons served with the Notice are attached to the Application as Attachment A.

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# II. <u>Conclusion</u>

Deferred accounting treatment is an appropriate, just and reasonable means of

implementing Order 07-015 and PGE Schedule 126

For the reasons stated above, PGE requests permission to defer annual net variable power

cost variances pursuant to Order No. 07-015 and PGE tariff Schedule 126.
