The City of Portland is pleased to submit this letter in support of Portland General Electric's Testbed Proposal. The Testbed objectives and outcomes support the City's climate action goals, which are specifically outlined in the 2015 Climate Action Plan and in the 100 Percent Renewables resolution, passed by Portland City Council in 2017. We understand that the deployment and integration of energy efficiency, demand response and distributed energy resources are critical to PGE's efforts to decarbonize the electricity system. The City is excited to partner and learn about smart grid deployment alongside PGE in this important effort.

The City has participated in the Demand Response Review Committee and in that capacity, will continue to work with PGE to ensure that a social equity lens is applied consistently throughout the Testbed.
