Administrative Law Judge Mapes:

On December 28, 2022, Chief Administrative Law Judge Moser issued a Memorandum Regarding Schedule for Oral Argument in the above-captioned docket. This Memorandum provides structure for the oral argument scheduled for January 5, 2023. It notes that PacifiCorp dba Pacific Power is assumed to be providing oral argument for the stipulating parties and that Vitesse will not be participating in the oral argument.

Having had the opportunity to confer with the other signatory parties to the Fourth Partial Stipulation, I write to clarify that both PacifiCorp and Staff for the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Staff) will be participating in the Opening Statement portion of the oral argument. The allocated time set forth in the December 28, 2022 Memorandum is sufficient and Staff does not request additional time. PacifiCorp and Staff intend to share the allotted time.

It is also our understanding that Vitesse does not plan to participate in the oral argument. However, representatives of all of the stipulating parties will be present and available to address questions and specific issues as may be appropriate.
