Dear Judge Power:

Although this is not a formal response to Wah Chang's Reply to PacifiCorp's Motion to Strike, we do wish to offer a possible resolution for your consideration. We understand from Wah Chang's Reply that if PacifiCorp is permitted to submit sur-rebuttal testimony with respect to the Howard study, Wah Chang requests: (1) that such testimony should be prefiled in its entirety, (2) that Wah Chang be permitted an opportunity to conduct some discovery on such testimony, and (3) that Wah Chang be provided an opportunity to reply to the supplemental testimony. PacifiCorp does not object to these requirements, and it seems they can be accommodated under the existing schedule. PacifiCorp would be prepared to prefile its supplemental testimony on Monday, July 30, and to expedite the responses to any data requests from Wah Chang with respect to such supplemental testimony (so long as limited to the scope of such supplemental testimony). If Wah Chang submits its data requests by close of business on Tuesday, July 31 and assuming responses to such requests are provided no later than Friday, August 3, we could proceed with a one-day hearing on either Tuesday, August 7 or Wednesday, August 8. (Based on the cross-examination statements, it appears that only one day of hearings is necessary.) At such hearing, Wah Chang could present further testimony from the stand, limited in scope to a response to the PacifiCorp supplemental testimony.
