AT&T Corp.

AT&T Corp. objects to this request to the extent that it requests information that the

company does not maintain in the ordinary course of business, is not readily available, and would be burdensome to produce. AT&T Corp. also objects to this request to the extent it seeks information about services that are not subject to the Commission's jurisdiction. In addition, AT&T Corp. notes that there is information at <u>http://www.puc.state.or.us/Pages/highspeedinternetmaps.aspx</u> regarding broadband services available in the state.

Subject to and without waiving its objections, AT&T Corp. provides the following response:

- a. To the extent that AT&T Corp. provides terrestrial-based broadband service as defined by the ALJ in any OUSF-supported exchange, Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) service is offered over those facilities.
- b. To the extent that AT&T Corp. provides any terrestrial-based broadband service as defined by the ALJ in any OUSF-supported exchange the service is offered over its own facilities.

c. AT&T Corp. does not have market penetration information readily available. When available, AT&T Corp. will provide a confidential supplement to this response with the OUSF-supported exchanges in which it currently provides terrestrial-based broadband services to at least one customer.

AT&T Mobility:

AT&T Mobility objects to this request to the extent that it requests information that the company does not maintain in the ordinary course of business, is not readily available, and would be burdensome to produce. AT&T also objects to this request to the extent it

seeks information for "all non-ILEC providers of terrestrial-based broadband services, including...wireless providers" because as a commercial mobile radio service ("CMRS") provider, AT&T Mobility is generally not subject to the Commission's jurisdiction. In addition, AT&T Mobility notes that there is information at

- b. To the extent that AT&T Mobility provides any terrestrial-based broadband service as defined by the ALJ in any OUSF-supported exchange the service is offered over its own facilities.
