8 In response to Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) Lackey’s October 25, 2019 Ruling, the
9 parties to this proceeding hereby provide a status update. The parties to this case were invited to
10 participate in discussions on October 30, 2019 and November 7, 2019 to attempt resolution of
11 the Phase I compliance filing issues discussed at the October 22, 2019 Regular Public Meeting.
12 Following these discussions, Staff, the Alliance of Western Energy Consumers (AWEC),
13 Calpine Energy Solutions, LLC (Calpine), Northwest and Intermountain Power Producers
14 Coalition (NIPPC), Oregon Citizens’ Utility Board (CUB), Portland General Electric (PGE), and
15 Renewable Northwest have reached an agreement in principle, with some details to be further
16 discussed, that addressés issues raised in OPUC Order No. 19-348.¹ Avangrid Renewables, NW
17 Energy Coalition, PacifiCorp, and Walmart Inc. have not raised objections to the agreement in
18 principle. Therefore, the parties anticipate making an appropriate filing for amendment and/or
19 clarification of Order 19-075 to effectuate the agreement resolving these issues, and do not find


