CORRECTED STAFF RESPONSE TO
PACIFICORP MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE

22 In a motion filed March 22, 2022, PacifiCorp moves to consolidate this docket, UE 399,
23 with deferral dockets UM 1964, UM 2134, UM 2142, UM 2167, UM 2185, UM 2186. Staff of
24 the Public Utility Commission of Oregon (Staff) has no objection to the consolidation of these
25 dockets, which were referenced in the Company's Opening Testimony.

1 Staff notes that deferrals and related amortizations can be addressed as relevant within a
2 general rate case, whether or not the deferral docket has been consolidated with the rate case.
3 Staff, for its part, intends to consider in this docket amortization of the 2020 and 2021 calendar
4 year deferrals in Docket UM 2063 (PacifiCorp’s Application for Deferred Accounting of Costs
5 Associated with the COVID-19 Public Health Emergency).
