NEWSUN ENERGY, LLC'S CROSS-EXAMINATION STATEMENT

Pursuant to Administrative Law Judge Mapes November 3, 2022 Ruling, NewSun Energy, LLC (NewSun) submits this cross-examination statement for the November 18, 2022 hearing on the Fourth Partial Stipulation filed in this docket on September 30, 2022.

- 4. NewSun intends to cross-examine the following witnesses that sponsored the Joint Testimony in Support of the Fourth Partial Stipulation and Joint Response Testimony in Support of the Fourth Partial Stipulation:
  - a. Matthew McVee, Madison Bolton, Will Gehrke, Alex Kronauer, Bradley Cebulko, and Spencer Gray.
  - b. Because the Joint Testimony and Joint Response Testimony are both sponsored in their entirety by each of the above-referenced witnesses, without specifying whether a specific witness is sponsoring any particular portion of the testimony, NewSun reserves the right to cross-examine each of the witnesses individually about any portion of the Joint Testimony or Joint Response Testimony.
  - c. NewSun estimates that cross-examination will take approximately one (1)

hour and will not include discussion of any confidential information.

d. The topics for cross-examination may include: The Fourth Partial Stipulation, the proposed Accelerated Commitment Tariff in proposed Schedule 273; the terms and conditions of industry standard wholesale Power Purchase Agreements (PPAs); the terms and conditions of PacifiCorp PPA's; commercially reasonable remedies for the underdelivery of power under any participating PPA's; the process for selecting replacement ACT resources; and other representations made in testimony in support of the Fourth Partial Stipulation.

NewSun also reserves the right to ask follow-up questions of any witness who is cross-examined by another party, the Administrative Law Judge, or any Commissioner.
