Idaho Power has negotiated an agreement with the Community Renewable Energy 15 Association ("CREA") whereby Idaho Power has agreed to waive cross examination of 16 CREA witness Dr. Don Reading in exchange for CREA's agreement to enter into the 17 record in this proceeding Dr. Don Reading's testimony from the Idaho Public Utilities 18 Commission Case No. GNR-11-03.1 CREA has also agreed to waive cross examination 19 of Idaho Power witness Mark Stokes in exchange for the Company's agreement to enter 20 into the record in this proceeding the Company's initial and supplemental response to 21 CREA's Data Request 3.3. 22
