Purpose of Workshop

Staff intends to provide utilities and stakeholders an opportunity to discuss utility transportation electrification (TE) portfolio budgeting under Staff's recommended TE Investment Framework. The workshop scope will focus on TE portfolio budgeting, methodology and assessment, and address use of ODOT's TE Infrastructure Needs Analysis (TEINA) tool to develop a maximum "guardrail" for infrastructure investments.
