

Notice of Public Workshop and Docket Schedule

AR 654 - Transportation Electrification Rulemaking

Through Order No. 21-484¹ (December 2021), the Commission adopted Staff's recommendation to explore the adoption of its Transportation Electrification (TE) Investment Framework in Oregon. The Order also directed Staff to commence a rulemaking in early 2022 to revise Division 87 of Oregon Administrative Rules Chapter 860 to formalize Staff's recommendations. With this Order, the UM 2165 investigation transitioned into a rulemaking, Docket No. AR 654. Staff notes that the intent of the rulemaking is to move quickly and incorporate the stakeholder input already collected in the UM 2165 investigation to align Division 87 with Executive Order 20-04 and HB 2165 (2021).

Staff invites stakeholders to attend a public workshop **Friday, February 4, from 3 – 5 pm Pacific Time.** The workshop will review the 2022 docket schedule and process for input, the TE Investment Framework and public comment received, use of ODOT's Transportation Electrification Infrastructure Needs Analysis (TEINA) model, and key topics for the Division 87 rulemaking.
