Pursuant to Oregon Administrative Rule 860-032-0020 (5) and (11), SBC Long Distance, LLC dba AT&T Long Distance ("AT&T LD") is hereby providing the Public Utility Commission of Oregon notification that it will cease providing business local exchange services for business access lines including all packages and bundles such as: Phone Solutions and Phone Solutions Plus, Primary Rate ISDN (PRI), Digital Trunks (DTS), and T-1 Integrated Access (IAS) in Aloha, Beaverton, Clackamas, Cornelius, Gresham, Hillsboro, Lake Oswego, McMinnville, Milwaukie, Oregon City, Portland, Tigard, Tualatin, West Linn and Wilsonville Oregon effective April 30, 2008. AT&T LD will continue offering long distance telecommunications service.

AT&T Long Distance has twenty-one business customers and they will be notified by mail of this action. The customers have been given the opportunity to select another carrier on an individual basis. A copy of the notice that will be sent to the customer December 21, 2007 is attached. No other providers are affected by this action.

### Important Notice Regarding Discontinuance of Local Telephone Service

Dear Valued AT&T Business Customer:

AT&T values your business, and we'd like to update you on some important changes underway. As you may know, in November 2005, AT&T Corp. and SBC Communications Inc. joined together to form the new AT&T. As part of the integration process, the affiliated companies are streamlining their business service portfolios. As a result, several local telephone service offerings by SBC in the cities of Aloha, Beaverton, Clackamas, Cornelius, Gresham, Hillsboro, Lake Oswego, McMinnville, Milwaukie, Oregon City, Portland, Tigard, Tualatin, West Linn and Wilsonville Oregon are being phased out.

As a result, this letter is to provide you 90 day notice that your service is among some local telephone service offerings by AT&T Long Distance (formerly SBC Long Distance) that are being phased out in Oregon. It is our intention, subject to regulatory approval, to discontinue these services starting on March 31, 2008 and completing by April 30, 2008.

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SBC Long Distance will no longer provide the following products:

- Business Access Lines including all packages and bundles such as: Phone Solutions and Phone Solutions Plus.
- Primary Rate ISDN (PRI)
- Digital Trunks (DTS)
- T-1 Integrated Access (IAS)

Only the services listed above are impacted by this letter; other AT&T services such as long distance calling and transport, interLATA private line, frame and ATM services or local services from another affiliate, will not be affected by this action.

At this time, SBC Long Distance, LLC, d/b/a AT&T Long Distance ("SBC") provides you with local telephone service, using one of the above products. Accordingly, starting on March 31, 2008 and completing by April 30, 2008, SBC will no longer provide your local telephone service. **You must take immediate action.**

**YOUR ACTION IS REQUIRED!** To prevent interruption of your local business telephone service, you must select another service provider or another service from AT&T Communications Of The Pacific Northwest, Inc, ("AT&T") on or before March 18, 2008. This should allow enough time for your new local service provider to start your new phone service before our service is discontinued.

Please disregard this letter if you have already placed an order to transfer your local phone service to another service provider, or if you plan to move your service to AT&T prior to March 31, 2008.

You are a valued customer. We sincerely hope you will remain with AT&T. However, you also have the right to select another local telephone service provider, and can discontinue your current service without penalty. If you select another provider, that carrier will be able to provide you with a list of their services and charges. You may also look in the front of your Yellow Pages directory under "telephone companies," or in the front of your White Pages directory for a list of local telephone service providers. Once you find the provider of your choice, you should call that provider to order your new service.

If you have not yet made arrangements to move your service to AT&T or to transfer your business local phone service to an alternate service provider, you must do so on or before March 18, 2008 to prevent the loss of your local business telephone service. If you act by this date, there will be sufficient time to start your new service before your current service ends. If you do not act by this date, you could lose your local phone service on March 31, 2008. Also, you will need to work with your local service provider to select a long distance service provider and to assure that you can keep your telephone number(s). Note that an alternate provider may refuse service to a customer if that customer owes an outstanding balance for jurisdictional services.

**If you do not select another local service provider promptly, your local telephone service will be disconnected, you will be without dial tone, and you may lose your ability to retain your existing telephone number(s).**

After you switch to another local telephone service provider and SBC discontinues your service, you will receive a final bill within 7 to 14 days. If we owe you a refund for payments or deposits, we will send it to you within 30 to 45 days. Please be aware that you are responsible for paying all bills from SBC.
