11	Pursuant to the Administrative Law Judge's May 2, 2023 Memorandum Requesting		
12	Proposals for Procedural Schedules in the above-captioned matter, Staff of the Oregon Public		
13	Utility Commission (Staff) submits the proposed procedural schedule set forth below. Staff has		
14	conferred with counsel for the City of Portland, and he supports the proposed procedural		
15	schedule.		
16	The proposed procedural schedule includes three rounds of pre-filed written testimony.		
17	As the OPUC Staff has the burden of proof, the proposed schedule provides the OPUC Staff		
18	opportunity to file testimony first (Opening Testimony) and last (Reply Testimony). The City o		
19	Portland and Intervenors have the opportunity to file Response Testimony after OPUC Staff files		
20	Opening Testimony.		
21	The procedural schedule includes a window for a cross-examination hearing, to be set at		
22	the Administrative Law Judge's and Commission's convenience, followed by three rounds of		
23	briefs, with OPUC Staff filing the first and last brief (Opening and Reply) and the City of		
24	Portland and Intervenors filing the second brief (Response). The first brief will be due four		
25	weeks after the due date for the Cross-examination Statements if there is no hearing, and will be		
26	due four weeks from the date of hearing if there is a hearing for cross-examination.		
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The proposed schedule is as follows:
