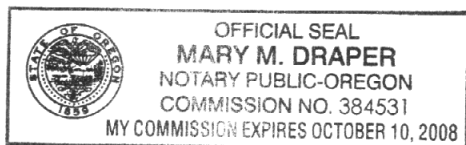



Announcing a new wind farm to help meet your future electricity needs.

Our region's demand for electricity is growing by about two percent annually. In 2006, PGE welcomed almost 13,000 new customers. That's like adding another town about the size of Oregon City every year!

PGE is providing the electricity you need while being good stewards of Oregon's environment. Here's how we're doing it:

- We're completing construction of a super-efficient power plant at Port Westward in Columbia County.
- We're buying more power from Oregon wind farms.
- We're building a new wind farm at Biglow Canyon.

The Biglow Canyon project will be located in Sherman County, Oregon, and consist of 76 new wind turbines.

What's the bottom line for PGE customers?

A proposed electricity price increase would pay for the new wind project. On March 2, 2007 PGE filed a request with the Oregon Public Utility Commission (OPUC) to increase base rates an average of 0.8 percent, or \$13 million annually beginning Jan. 1, 2008. The price changes for the majority of customer types (which include supplemental adjustments) would be:

Customer type	Average increase
Residential (Schedule 7)	0.8 percent
Small Business (Schedule 32)	0.8 percent
Large business and industrial (Schedules 83, 89)	1.0 percent

The typical PGE residential customer using 900 kilowatt-hours per month would see an increase of \$0.65 in their monthly bill.

You can have a say in the process

Prices are set for Oregon's investor-owned utilities in a public process called a rate case. It is conducted by the OPUC and includes significant involvement from customer groups, local governments and other parties. You are welcome to join the process.
