

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

Dear Filing Center:

The Industrial Customers of Northwest Utilities ("ICNU") files this letter clarifying its \$70,020 proposed budget for an issue fund grant under the First Amended and Restated Intervenor Funding Agreement ("IFA"). According to section 6.3(f) of the IFA, any intervenor must represent that it will "use matching funds in the form of either in-house resources or outside funding to account for or pay at least 20% of the Eligible Expenses for the work to be performed for which the intervenor is seeking an Issue Fund Grant." As has occurred in many past proceedings, ICNU will likely spend more than the amount it is requesting in its Proposed Budget and will likely spend more than \$70,020. As a result, ICNU proposes that the total amount requested for an issue fund grant in UE 200 remain \$70,020. Regardless of the total amount ICNU spends in the proceeding, ICNU will use its own funds to pay at least 20% of the work it performs in UE 200, and will not request payment from the Issue Fund of more than 80% of its total costs incurred in this proceeding.


